EASTERN AVENUE, KEENE


DIRECTIONS:

From the intersection of Water Street and Eastern Avenue: Drive south on Eastern Avenue. The crossing begins just south of Water Street and continues to the intersection with Chapman Road.

From the intersection of Marlboro Street and Eastern Avenue:

Drive north on Eastern Avenue for approximately 0.1 mile. The crossing begins just north of the intersection with Chapman Road and ends just before the "T" at Water Street.

NOTE: This crossing stretches a full 0.5 mile, from Water Street all the way to Chapman Road. However, the heaviest concentrations of wood frogs occur in two spots (designated by salamanders on the map): (1) between the intersection with Lorraine Street and the bridge just south of Bellevue Street, and (2) just north of the intersection with Chapman Road. Amphibian activity does not extend south of the bike path parking lot.



OTHER INFO:



This is a highly residential neighborhood, so please

exercise extreme courtesy. It's also a heavily-traveled road with fast-moving traffic and narrow shoulders, and is therefore **not recommended for children**!



The amphibians at this site are almost exclusively frogs.



PARKING: Park in the parking lot for the Cheshire Rail Trail, approximately 0.1 mile north of the intersection with Marlboro Street and across the street from the intersection with Chapman Road. The parking lot is on the west side of the road.
