## **SUMMER STREET, PETERBOROUGH**

## **DIRECTIONS:**

From the intersection of Summer Street and Main Street in downtown Peterborough: Drive north on Summer Street for about 1.2 miles. The crossing begins just north of the dirt parking lot for a small power station on the right-hand (east) side of the road. It ends where the bike path is immediately adjacent to the road.

**NOTE:** This crossing is approximately 0.2 mile long.

## **OTHER INFO:**




There are pools on both sides of the road, but most of

the amphibian movement is from a forested, uphill slope (to the west) into wetlands between the road and the bike path (to the east).



Use caution! Traffic can be fast-moving here, particularly on

weekend nights.





**PARKING**: Park in the dirt lot for the small power station on the right-hand (east) side of the road if you're coming from downtown Peterborough. You may also park at the bike path trailhead a bit further south.
