

# SWANZEY LAKE ROAD, SWANZEY

## DIRECTIONS:

### From Swanzey Center:

Drive south on Route 32. In about 2 miles, turn right on Swanzey Lake Road. From the center of town, Swanzey Lake Road is the fourth road on the right-hand (west) side of Route 32. The crossing begins approx. 0.4 mile from the intersection of Route 32 and Swanzey Lake Road. It ends at a private dirt road called Lewis Road, which is the second road on the right-hand (west) side of Swanzey Lake Road, if you're coming from Route 32.

**NOTE:** This crossing is about 0.2 mile long.

## OTHER INFO:



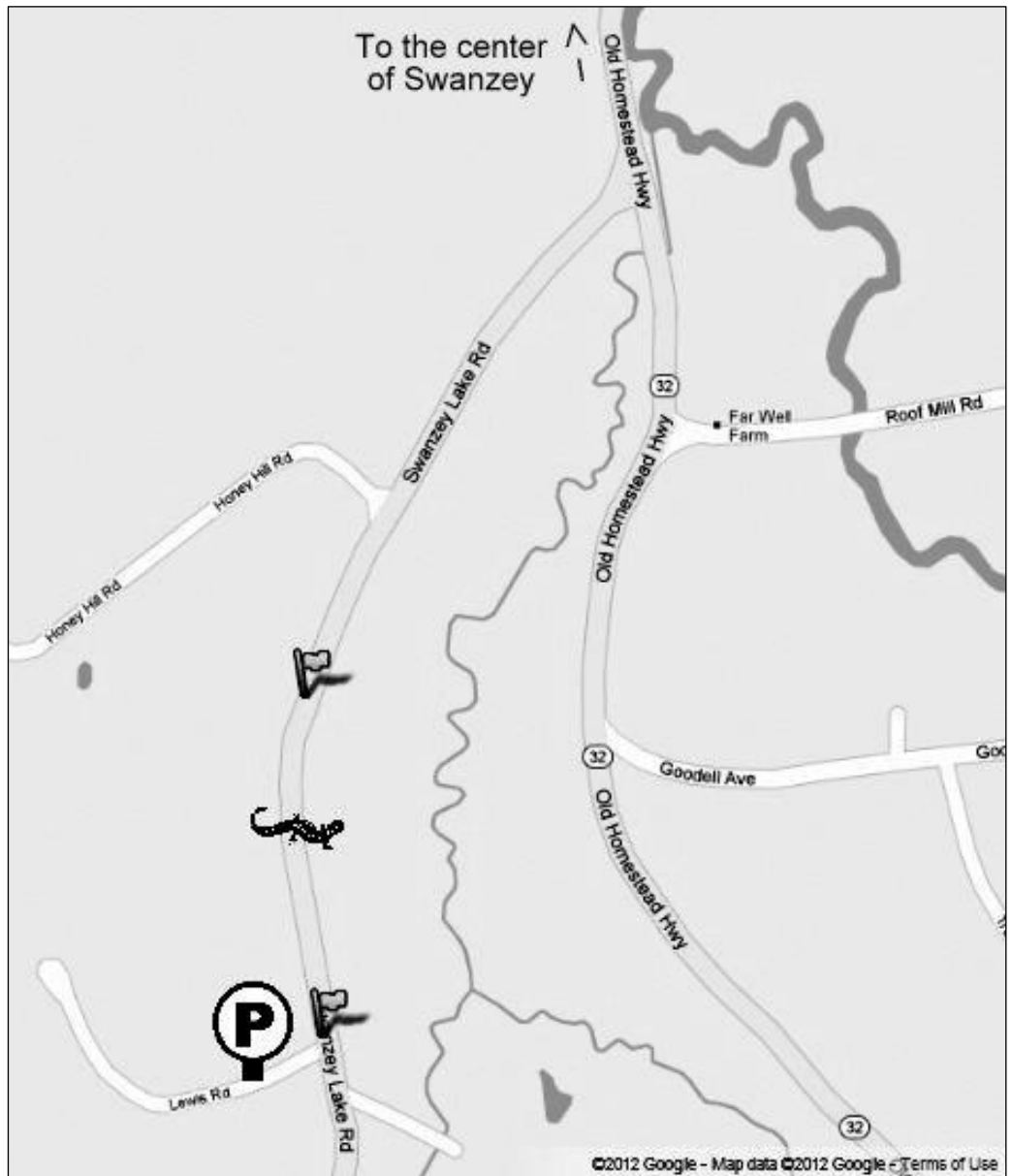
If you like variety, you'll want to come here! This site has seen salamanders of all shapes and sizes, including redback, four-toed, two-lined, and the charismatic spotted salamander.



Traffic doesn't tend to be too heavy at this site, but there is a very narrow embankment, so please exercise caution!



**PARKING:** Park along the side of Lewis Road. Please do *not* park on Swanzey Lake Road, as it's easy to slip into the culvert. One year, a volunteer needed to be towed out.
