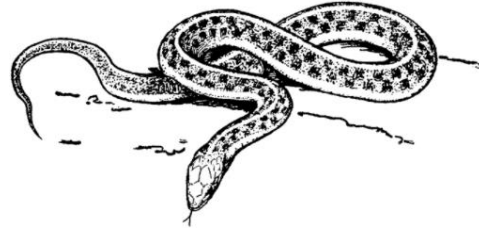


It's a SNAKE!
