

JORDAN ROAD, KEENE

DIRECTIONS:

From the intersection of Jordan and Peg Shop Roads: Drive north on Jordan Road. The crossing begins just before 61 Jordan Road and ends near 99 Jordan Road, where a metal side railing begins on the lefthand (west) side of the road.

NOTE: This crossing is approximately 0.2 mile long.

OTHER INFO:



Jordan Road is a great place to get a good look at Jefferson complex salamanders, which are a Species of Special Concern in New Hampshire! About halfway through the crossing site, there is a tall streetlight on the downhill side of the road. Most of the Jefferson salamander activity occurs in the vicinity of this streetlight, or between the streetlight and 99 Jordan Road.



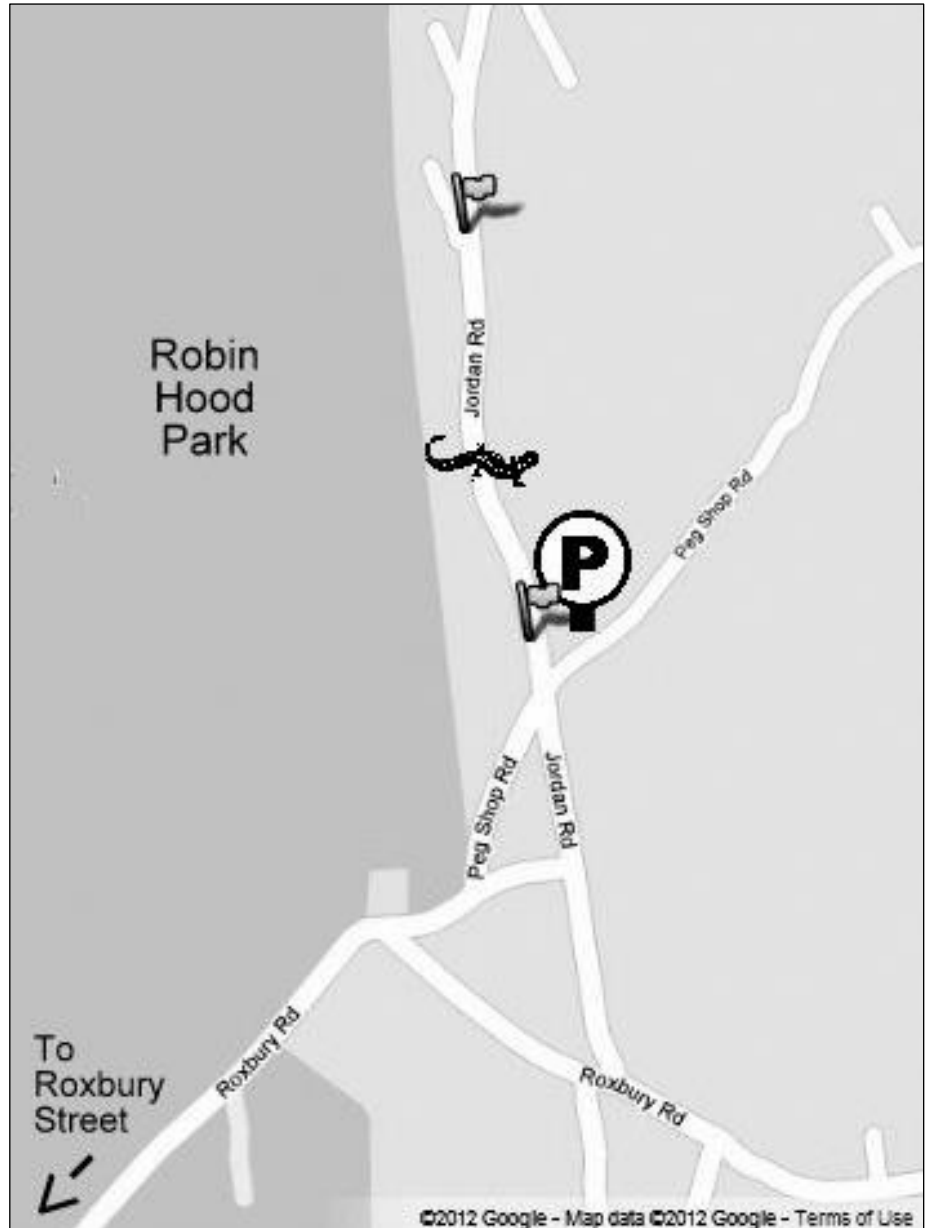
Jordan Road is high in elevation and therefore tends to be a few degrees colder than the rest of Keene.

PARKING: After the intersection of Jordan and Peg Shop Roads, pull off onto the righthand (east) side of Jordan Road. Try to park as close to the intersection as possible, without parking in the intersection. **Please be careful not to park in or block residents' driveways.**
