

WHITING HILL ROAD, WILTON

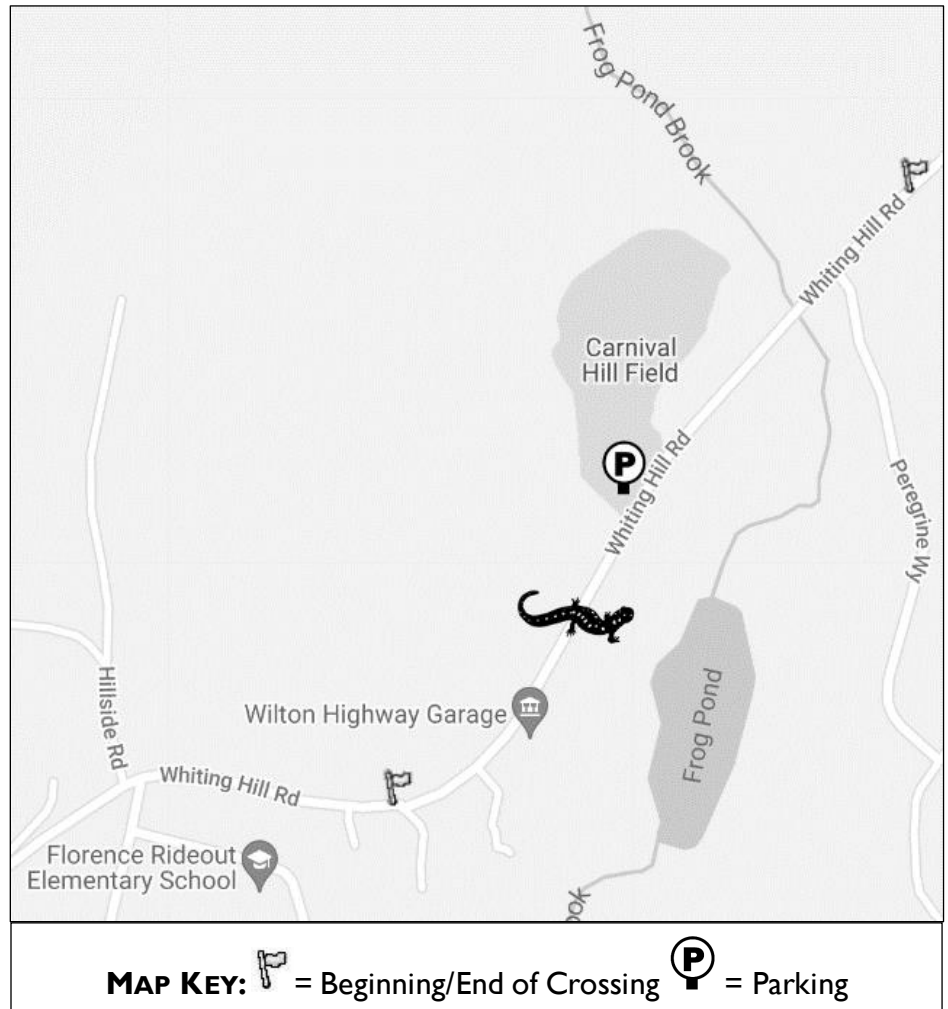
DIRECTIONS:

From Main Street in Wilton:

Turn north onto Park Street and continue to the end of the road, then turn right onto Whiting Hill Road. The crossing begins in approx. 0.2 mile. Parking is available at Carnival Hill, 0.4 mile after the turn onto Whiting Hill Road.

From Mont Vernon: Turn south onto Wilton Road and continue for 2 miles. Turn right onto Hutchinson Road, which becomes North Purgatory Road, and then Purgatory Road. After 1.5 miles, turn right onto Center/Lyndeborough Road. After 1.4 miles, turn left onto Perham Corner/Whiting Hill Road. The crossing begins in 1 mile. Parking is available at Carnival Hill, approx. 1.2 miles after the turn onto Whiting Hill Road.

NOTE: This crossing is approx. 0.5 mile long.



OTHER INFO:



This area has low traffic, good sight lines, street lights, and wide shoulders, making it a **family-friendly site**.



Whiting Hill Road is a great place to see a diversity of amphibians — from wood frogs, spring peepers, green frogs, and pickerel frogs to spotted and red-backed salamanders.



PARKING: Ample parking can be found at the Carnival Hill Field. This parking area is within the crossing, so please **drive slowly and watch for volunteers and amphibians** when coming and going.
